## What type of course is this?

The one year full-time programme based at Keele University leads to the award of a Post/Professional Graduate Certificate in Education (PGCE), along with a recommendation for Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) for graduates wishing to teach in secondary schools. The OAKS (OSSMA & Keele SCITT) will coordinate the QTS aspects of training, and will take full responsibility for the support of trainees in Partnership schools.
