JACKIE TRENT (1940- 2015)

As a **pop-singer** in the 1960's she recorded 12 albums and **51 singles** but is best known as a songwriter alongside her husband Tony Hatch. They wrote songs for **Frank Sinatra**, Petula Clark and others including **"We'll be with you"** a **Stoke City anthem** still sung before every home game. While on tour in Australia they also wrote the **theme song** for the **Neighbours TV soap**.



Her real name was **Yvonne Anne Burgess**. Her stage name Trent was because of her love for Stoke on Trent, but she was **born in Chesterton**.





Should trick or treating go ahead this year?
